



Scholarship Opportunity

NCMA – Frederick Chapter Scholarship Application

TO APPLY:

Prospective applicants must:

1. Complete scholarship application form.
2. Desire to further their education in the field of Business, Contracting, Law, or Procurement, or a related field.
3. Submit a completed scholarship application, including two recent letters of recommendation (one from a teacher, counselor/advisor, or principal, and one from a point of contact in the community), an essay of no more than 500 words (topic specified on the application announcement), and recent transcript.
4. Prior to award of the scholarship the selected recipient must provide evidence of intent to study (e.g., acceptance letter, registration, payment receipt, etc.).

Evaluation & Selection Criteria

APPLICATION DUE DATE: See web site

Applicants for the Frederick Chapter scholarship(s) must meet the following criteria regarding professional orientation:

1. Must be a graduating senior in high school or a matriculating undergraduate/graduate student with at least six credit hours.
2. Must be a student in good standing at an accredited educational institution.
3. Must have a 2.8 or better throughout the high school program, or
4. Must have a 3.0 or better GPA for undergraduate degree, or 3.2 or better GPA for graduate work.
5. Must be pursuing a degree in contracting management or a contracting-related field, including but not limited to, business administration, law, political science, public administration, logistics, purchasing, production management, or materials management.
6. Must have demonstrated work experience or other appropriate interest in a contracting, or contracting-related career field.
7. Scholarships are only available to current NCMA members, in good standing, or family members.
